



# Assembly Guide

## TIPS

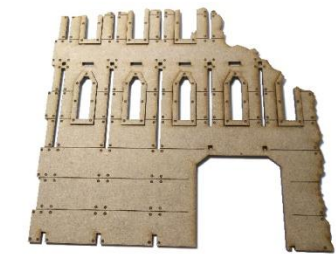
- To detach the parts from the board, press the anchor point with your thumb.
- Always push with your thumb on the engraved side of the board, so the piece falls under the board.
- You can easily locate the anchors points by looking at the back of the board.
- Use PVA glue diluted with a little water. (3 parts adhesive, 1 part of water).
- Use a small file to remove the anchor points' residues. You can also use a modeler's knife (handle it carefully to prevent injury).
- Use a small brush to spread the diluted glue.



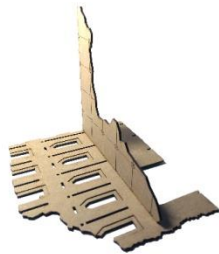
### Guide Iron City, Demolished Warehouse



*You can put a cardboard of the thickness you want under it, this elevate the piece on each side of the openings and equalize the recesses of each windows. Do not hesitate to move the cardboard around, to always have the same thickness under the edges already glued. For this manipulation, work on a perfectly flat surface.*



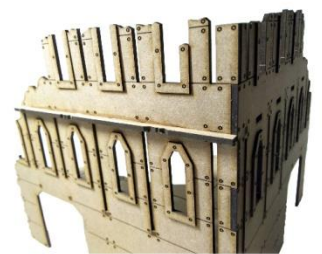
Take part [D], remove the windows from the openings and glue them back with the recess explained earlier. Do the same thing with part [E].



Take part [B], insert and glue it at the bottom of the slots on part [D].



Add part [C] on part [D] and add part [E] to form the corner.



Add part [G] on the top of part [E].



Add part [H] on the top of part [D].

*We advise you to glue the columns inside before the outside, it will be easier.*



All parts [I] are identical, they are planned for the ground floor and the first floor inside.



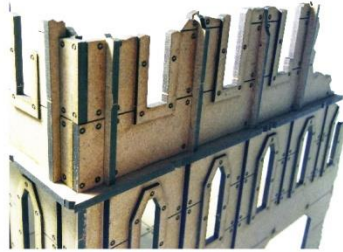
The parts [J] and [K] go into the interior corners on the ground floor and first floor. Glue part [J] first.



The parts [2-7] go on the second floor inside. Take your time to check where you want to place them before putting the glue.



The parts [1 and 8] go into the corner of the second floor, putting them in the same direction as those of the other floors.



The parts [1 to 8] go outside the walls on the second floor. You can place them where you want them, try them before gluing them.



The parts [F] go on each side of the outer corner.



There are four parts that fit into the slots above the arches.



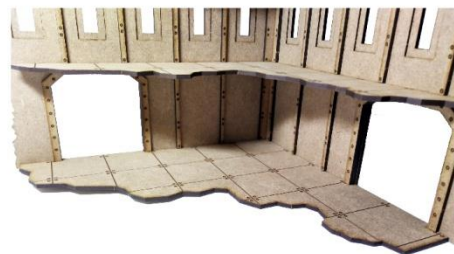
The four arch-shaped parts are glued to each side of the doors. Be careful, there are two sizes.



The shorter goes inside.



The tallest goes outside.



You just have to glue part [A] to complete the assembly.
